The Advanced International Certificate of Education (AICE) is an accelerated method of academic study administered and assessed through the University of Cambridge International Examinations.

The Cambridge approach supports schools to develop learners who are:

**CONFIDENT** in working with information and ideas - their own and those of others;

**RESPONSIBLE** for themselves, responsive to and respectful of others;

**REFLECTIVE** as learners, developing their ability to learn;

**INNOVATIVE** and equipped for new and future challenges;

**ENGAGED** intellectually and socially, ready to make a difference.

## **AICE DIPLOMA REQUIREMENTS**

The AICE diploma is a group certificate which requires students to draw from three curriculum areas. They must earn at least one credit in three subject groupings.

**GROUP A: Mathematics & Sciences** 

**GROUP B: Languages** 

GROUP C: Arts & Humanities REQUIRED: Global Perspectives

## Benefits of AICE

- Classes in which a passing grade is attained on the CIE are awarded college credit.
- Candidates who earn seven credits of AICE courses and examinations are awarded the AICE diploma directly by the University of Cambridge.
- Candidates who earn the AICE diploma and complete 100 hours of community service earn the Florida Bright Futures Academic Scholars Award.
- AICE offers students the opportunity to make academic course selections tailored to their individual interests, abilities, strengths, and future plans within an international curriculum framework.

## PRE-AICE COURSES

The AICE program of study offers students offers one of the most demanding and rigorous college preparatory programs in the world. After completing at least one course in the three academic areas, students will have the flexibility to choose a course of study that best meets their abilites and interests.
